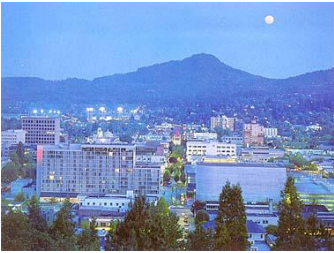
### CLINIC INFORMATION
