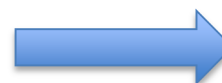

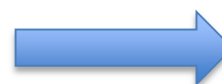

- COMT:
Certified Orthopedic Manipulative Therapist
- 4 courses (105 hours)
 - Written case presentations (4)
 - 4-Station Oral Practical Exam

Features:

- All courses open to any licensed PT at any time. Other professions as determined by NAIOMT board.
- 3rd year PT students eligible to take 511 and 516 courses and post course tests
- All examinations closed: Must take all NAIOMT classes to take NAIOMT exams. No challenges.
- Residents must complete all 500 + all 600 level courses + CMPT certification
- Fellows in training must complete all 500 + all 600 + all 700 courses + plus COMT certification
- Current C-801 course will move to specialty C-900 status
